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POTENTIAL IMPACT OF THE COVID-19 PANDEMIC

For now, we assume that 2021 IEEE IUS will be held according to the original plan in Xi'an where COVID-19 is well controlled. However, according to the current global COVID-19 pandemic and international traffic blockade, we are preparing for alternatives. Therefore, the committee will plan for a full virtual conference as a backup, depending on the international health and traffic situations in 2021. The hybrid format will be considered.

The annual IEEE IUS will be held at the Qujiang International Convention Center (QICC), from September 12-15, 2021

The abstracts should be submitted in electronic form according to the specific information posted on the conference web page. Each abstract will receive careful review and evaluation by the Symposium Technical Program Committee. Evaluation criteria will include originality of the work, contribution to the state-of the-art, and overall interest to the ultrasonics community. Papers are solicited for this conference describing original work in the field of ultrasonics from the following subject classifications and their cross-subjects:

- » Group 1: Medical Ultrasonics
- Group 2: Sensors, NDE & Industrial Applications
- » Group 3: Physical Acoustics
- >> Group 4: Microacoustics SAW, FBAR & MEMS
- » Group 5: Transducers & Transducer Materials
